David Best, the most celebrated

to 2004's A Temple of Stars which
spanned 1/3 of a mile and stood 110
feet high. These are truly spiritual
places that inspire and amaze.

Beyond Black Rock reveals how the
Burning Man event has evolved from
a fringe counterculture gathering to a
global community of artists and social
revolutionaries. Despite efforts by the
government and media to marginalize
the festival, Burning Man continues
to grow. The documentary includes
amazing imagery and entertaining
interviews that will increase your
knowledge and explain the intrigue of
the Burning Man phenomenon.
